Predators & Pests











Ways to prevent predators & pests

- Replace hole box with slot box (house sparrow)
- Staple fishing line to edge of roof (house sparrow)
- Move box away from the woods (house wren)
- Install predator guards (raccoons, snakes, weasels, cats)
 - Metal or plastic cone
 - PVC conduit
 - Stove pipe
 - Wire cage in front of hole/slot

More ways to prevent predators & pests

- Square-drive screws (humans)
- Use food grade DE (diatomaceous earth) in the nest box & at base of pole (ants & mites)
- Soap inside roof of box (wasps)
- Cooking oil spray (Pam, etc) (wasps)
- Use Snake B Gon at base of pole

Nest Activity Review

- Eggs
- Chicks
- Why Count?



Eggs

- Female lays 1 egg a day
- Incubation starts after last eggs is laid
- Incubation period: 11-19 days*
- Remove abandoned eggs & nest after21 days

* used to be 12-14 days



Chicks



- Nesting period: 17-21 days
- Count by looking for mouths
- Carefully open box after 14 days
- Clean out nest when all chicks are gone

Why Count?

To determine:

- Best start date for incubation
- Based on start date, when eggs should hatch, or if eggs have been abandon
- Based on hatching date, when the chicks are ready to fledge
- If any eggs or chicks are missing*
